

Trends




- The way we think, manage and experience health is undergoing tremendous changes



We identified 7 key focus areas to deliver sustained outcomes as health is reimagined through LIFEcare systems

Focus Areas



1. Consumer empowerment

Identify and deliver on what consumers value, e.g., use patient outcomes to measure success



2. Right care, place & time

Implement new models of 'integrated care' e.g., move from products to solutions



3. Keeping people healthy

Shift from treatment of illness to wellness. Increase health literacy be responsible for your health



4. Collaboration Model

Increase partnerships, e.g. PPP, new & established players to deliver consumer centered health services



5. Workforce of the Future

Build capabilities, e.g., digital and analytics, multidisciplinary teams, leadership and change mgmt., and leverage AI to complement workforce



6. Outcomes-based funding

Shift from volume to value to enable prevention to drive innovation and eliminate cost shifting e.g., integrate behavioral incentives and insurance



7. Digital, analytics & innovation

Leverage technology and data to deliver convenient, affordable, preventative and quality care, and strengthen cybersecurity for digital health



✓ Universal Healthcare Coverage





✓ Shift to Primary Care Model

Healthcare delivery in Abu Dhabi is adopting a new primary model of care that supports prevention and early detection (e.g. via Genome Oasis, Emirati Genome Program)



✓ International Collaboration and Accreditation

Providers in Abu Dhabi have established partnerships with academia (e.g. Harvard, Penn Med), industry (e.g. AZ, Lilly, G42), and healthcare providers (e.g. Cleveland Clinic, Imperial College)











✓ Public and Private Healthcare Providers

Abu Dhabi has setup public and private healthcare partnerships. Purehealth and SSMC are some of the most prominent public providers



✓ Healthcare Regulation & Oversight

The DoH is responsible for the oversight and regulation of the healthcare sector in Abu Dhabi (e.g. 1,512 drug coding applications registered, 28 medical devices approved)



Abu Dhabi has a focused strategy and is already delivering on focus areas thereby becoming a future health leader
